- Discuss the concept of procedural risk and how to select and de-select appropriate patients.
- Describe the four main risk factors to consider when treating medically complex patients

- Learn how to plan and implement a strategy for safe and effective dental treatment of patients with complex medical histories

- Learn what equipment and medications are needed to manage medical emergencies in the dental office
- Be capable of preparing and using the seven essential drugs recommend for the minimal dental emergency kit.

Dr. Goodchild maintains a private general dental practice in Jenkintown, PA.
