### Michigan Academy Of General Dentistry Presents: Mark Montana, DDS “Solutions for Implant Restorative Challenges with Edentulous Arches and Single Tooth Replacement”

#### The Edentulous Arch:

This presentation is appropriate for the dentist who is interested in greater understanding of the characteristics of treatment modalities for patients with an edentulous arch or arches. The emphasis of the presentation will include a comparative analysis of tissue-supported, implant-supported, fixed and removable solutions. By appreciating the value and limitations of available restorative options and materials, the attendee will gain confidence in prescribing the latest implant restorative innovations for their patients.

#### Single Tooth Replacement:

This presentation will focus on the challenges we encounter with an implant restoration among natural teeth. Although the esthetic mimicry of natural teeth may be convincing, the pathway to success may be complex as the implant and abutment are surrounded by a matrix that continually evolves. By using established analog workflows or state of the art digital technology, we can minimize complications and predictably provides our patients with an implant crown solution which incorporates function, esthetics, health, durability and ... retrievability.

At the conclusion of the seminar, participants will be able to:

- Understand the strengths and limitations of current restorative materials and methods for full-arch implant restoration
- Recognize which treatment modality addresses the needs unique to a patient
- Solutions for dealing with complexities that occur between teeth and implants
- The challenges of making the fully artificial co-exist with natural teeth
- How to design implant crowns for today and to meet the needs of tomorrow

#### Biography:

Dr. Montana is a 1987 graduate of the University of Southern California School of Dentistry and completed his Certification in Advanced Prosthodontics at USC in 1989. He has been primarily involved in private practice in Tempe, Arizona; emphasizing fixed, removable and implant prosthodontics. Dr. Montana has been involved in clinical instruction while attending USC and as a pre-clinical instructor at the Arizona School of Dentistry. He has lectured domestically and internationally on the topics of implant, fixed and removable prosthodontics. He has served on several of his states' dental committees. His memberships to professional organizations include the American College of Prosthodontics, the Academy of Osseointegration, and the Academy of Fixed Prosthodontics, The Pacific Coast Society for Prosthodontics and the American and Arizona Dental Associations.
