Course Synopsis & Objectives:

This course is designed for dentists and hygienists who want a practical, real-world approach to caring for pediatric patients. From infant oral health and caries prevention to behavior guidance, restorative decision making, trauma, growth and development, airway concerns, and referral strategies, this course breaks pediatric dentistry down into clear, usable concepts for everyday practice. Attendees will leave with greater confidence in recognizing what is normal, what needs intervention, what can be managed in general practice, and when referral matters.

Learning Objectives

1. Identify key milestones in pediatric oral growth and development
2. Apply prevention-focused strategies for infants, children, and adolescents
3. Use practical behavior guidance techniques during pediatric visits
4. Recognize and manage common pediatric restorative and trauma situations

7. Participate in hands-on demonstrations and case-based exercises focused on behavior guidance, restorative techniques, trauma assessment, preventive materials, and pediatric airway/growth evaluation for everyday clinical practice.

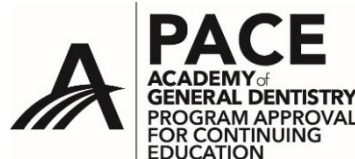
